Catch-up Distribution – March 30, 2012

The Penn Traffic Company Plan Administrator, WDC Solutions, Ltd., has determined that a catch-up distribution with respect to newly Allowed General Unsecured Claims (Class 3) is appropriate at this time. If your claim was recently allowed, the check you received is for 7.00% of your allowed claim. The 7.00% is comprised of the 2.00% initial distribution, 1.00% second distribution and 4.00% third distribution already paid to claimants whose General Unsecured Claims were previously allowed. The Plan Administrator anticipates that additional distributions to Holders of Allowed General Unsecured Claims will follow, but such distributions are not assured.

Pursuant to the Plan, the Company, in its catch-up distribution, is also paying recently Allowed Administrative Claims, Allowed Priority Claims and Allowed Convenience Claims (as defined in the Plan).
