Second Distribution – June 30, 2011

The Penn Traffic Company Plan Administrator, WDC Solutions, Ltd., in consultation with the Penn Traffic Post-Confirmation Oversight Committee, determined that an additional (second) distribution, of 1.00% of the amount of each Allowed General Unsecured Claim (Class 3), should be made at this time. On March 1, 2011 an initial distribution of 2.00% was made to holders of Allowed General Unsecured Claims. The second distribution checks will be issued on June 30, 2011. The total approved distribution with respect to Allowed General Unsecured Claims is now 3.00%.

If you participated in the initial distribution of 2.00% of the allowed amount of your claim, the check issued to you on June 30, 2011 represents your incremental distribution of 1.00%. If your claim was recently allowed, the check you receive is for 3.00% of your allowed claim (2.00% initial distribution and 1.00% second distribution). The Plan Administrator anticipates that additional distributions to Holders of Allowed General Unsecured Claims will follow, but such distributions are not assured.

Pursuant to the Plan, the Company, in its second distribution, is also paying recently Allowed Administrative Claims, Allowed Priority Claims and Allowed Convenience Claims (as defined in the Plan). (Please see [Additional Information](#) for classification and treatment of all Allowed Claims). For holders of Allowed Administrative Claims, Allowed Priority Claims and Allowed Convenience Claims, this distribution is in full payment and satisfaction of such claims.
