Supplemental Distribution – July 28, 2016

An Order granting a Final Decree and closing The Penn Traffic Company bankruptcy case was issued on October 19, 2015. The Order also approved procedures relating to the Final Distribution and, if it became necessary, procedures for a Supplemental Distribution. The Penn Traffic Company issued a Final Distribution, of 2.63% of the amount of each Allowed General Unsecured Claim (Class 3). Holders of allowed Class 3 claims received Distributions totaling 13.13% of the Allowed face amount of their Claims. A portion of the Final Distribution was determined to be unclaimed property and, along with other residual property, constitutes “Residual Funds”. As the Plan Administrator anticipated, the Residual Funds exceed \$50,000, requiring a Supplemental Distribution. As stipulated in the Order, The Penn Traffic Company is issuing a distribution of those funds to holders of Class 3 claims whose pro-rata portion of that Supplemental Distribution is at least \$100.00.
